HOW DOES IT WORK?

Citrix Presentation Server Web Interface for Microsoft SharePoint integrates with SharePoint solutions in two main ways:

- **Application enumeration and publishing**—Enumerates applications and displays the application icons inside the Web part for users. Applications are launched from the Web part using pass-through authentication providing single-click launching.
- **Content Redirection**—Access documents and content are made available through the portal using applications hosted on Presentation Server. The system intelligently determines which application needs to be launched on Presentation Server or on the client's desktop in order to open the document or content requested by the end user.

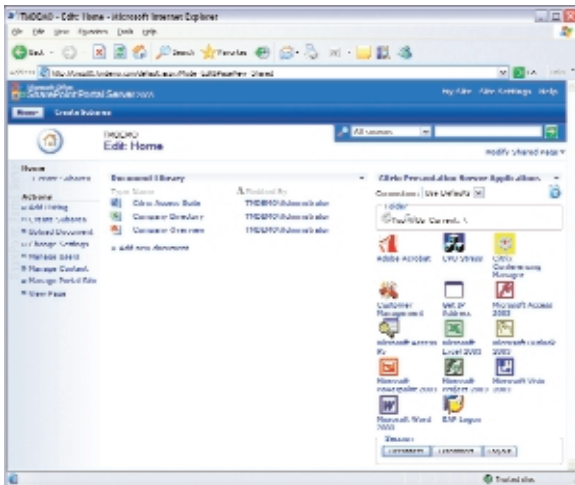


Figure 1. Presentation Server Web Interface for Microsoft SharePoint

Presentation Server Web Interface for Microsoft SharePoint will be available as a software download only from www.MyCitrix.com by December 2005. It requires Citrix Presentation Server 3.0 or Presentation Server 4.0.
